Subject: Charging of the commodities including the drugs and medical devices over and above the MRP regarding - reg.

Sir,

The undersigned is directed to refer to the above mentioned subject and to state that rule 18(2) of the Legal Metrology (Packaged Commodities), Rules 2011 provides that:

“No retail dealer or other person including manufacturer, packer, importer and wholesale dealer shall make any sale of any commodity in packed form at a price exceeding the retail sale price thereof.”

2. Therefore, it is hereby required to ensure that no pre packaged commodities including the drugs (like Remdesivir etc) and medical devices (like oxygen concentrators, cylinders etc) are charged over and above the MRP by the sellers.
